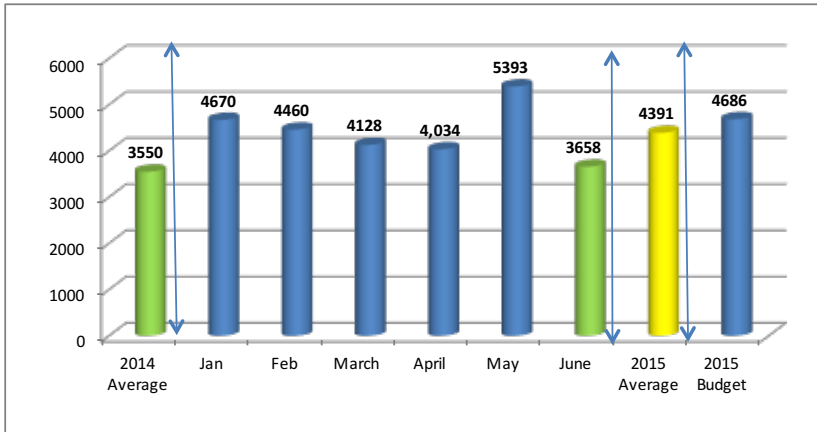
## **Paul turning 70**
