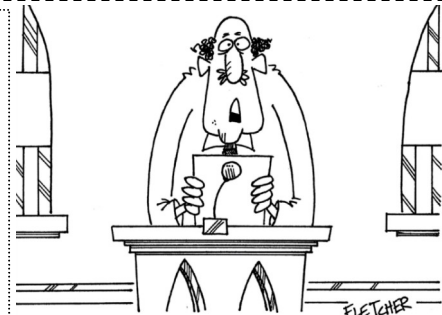


Dayboro Combined Churches Present their 2nd Annual Carol Singing in the Streets
