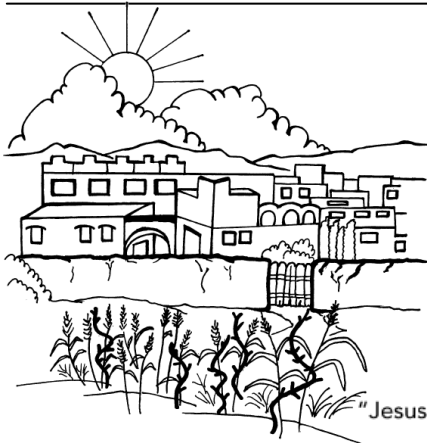


Sunday

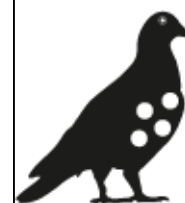
