Urgent call to halt persecution of Rohingyas

Uniting Church in Australia President Stuart McMillan<u>urged the Australian Government</u> to work to end the brutal violence against the Rohingya people in Myanmar:

"The Australian Government must urgently work alongside the international community to halt what is justifiably being described as the <u>ethnic cleansing</u> of the Rohingya minority by military forces.

"I echo calls from the <u>Grand Mufti of Australia</u> Dr Ibhahim Abu Mohammed for the Government to allocate a new quota for the arrival of Rohingya refugees into Australia.

"Australia must do whatever we can to support those who have fled and who cannot return home."
