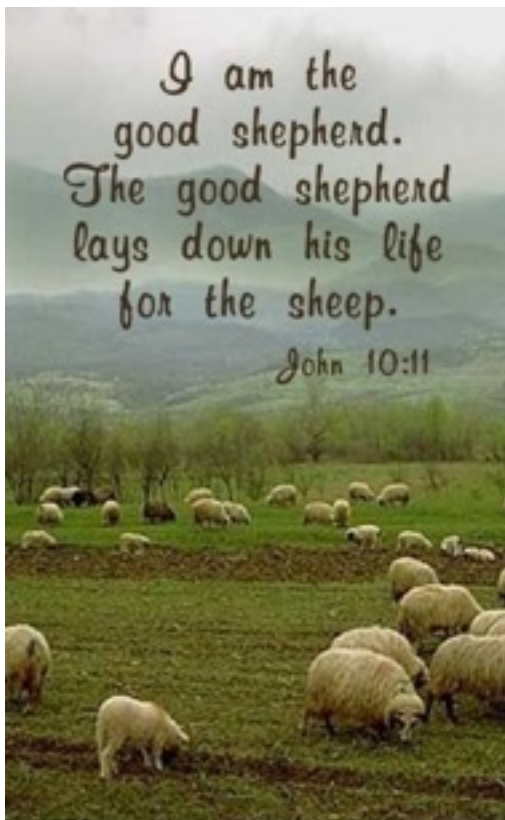


**Welcome to worship

- Has to be clean, not broken, no missing parts
- Glassware, crockery, china, vases sell well
- Framed pictures, jewellery, ornaments are fine
- Soft toys in good condition are welcome
- Games, puzzles, toys, Lego, etc are fine.
- Clothing in good condition
- Or ask Paul if not sure.

If you donate to the stall, you need to be prepared for us to dump what is not purchased.
