ECU to become Queensland Country after 1 September 2017

From September 1, Dayboro Uniting Church's bank account details will change. People who currently direct debit their offering by regular automatic electronic transfers, DO NOT need to take any action. However, NEW or AD HOC transfers set up after September 1, will be using a new account number. The BSB number remains the same. The new account number is expected to be 22046043 for the general account. We expect to be able to confirm these new details in September.

Mainly Music – Fun, interactive music sessions for young children and their parents/carers. Come and join our happy band of volunteers!

We are inviting expressions of interest to fill the vacancy of 'Program Presenter' for 2018.

There are 6 - 8 pre-prepared 30-minute sessions that introduce children to music, creativity and more, plus families are given a chance to think about the God-part of life in a loving, shared family environment. The sessions are presented rotationally complete with props, music, Powerpoint and books for story-time at the end of the program.

All you need as the Presenter is ENERGY and an ability to engage with children, new-born to school age. We meet every Tuesday during the School Term at 9.30am in the Church Hall.

Currently, we have 16 families enrolled with some 19 babies, toddlers and pre-schoolers attending, many of whom will continue in 2018.

Other volunteers meet and greet the children, present the Powerpoint, prepare morning tea for all, and help with setting up and cleaning at the end of each session.

All volunteers are required to be a Blue Card holder and have a church affiliation.
