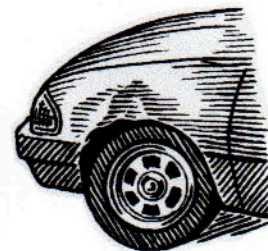


Packing day: Wednesday 17th December – packing from 9am; deliveries, hopefully from 1pm.
