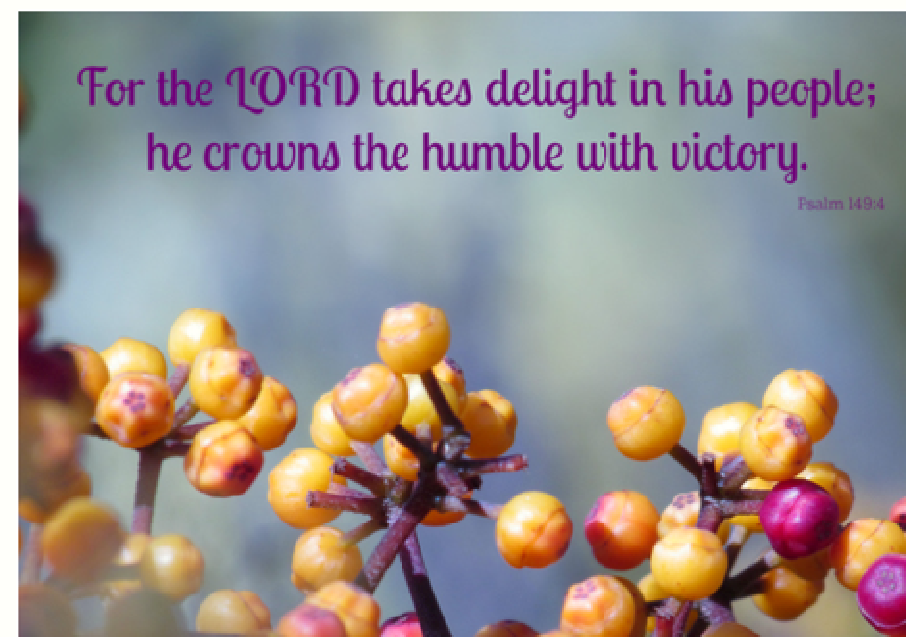

Mainly Music – Fun, interactive music sessions for young children and their parents/carers.

We are inviting expressions of interest to fill the vacancy of 'Program Presenter' for 2018.

There are 6 - 8 pre-prepared 30-minute sessions that introduce children to music, creativity and more, plus families are given a chance to think about the God-part of life in a loving, shared family environment.
