
OFFERING TRENDS 30 SEPTEMBER 2015



Notes:

- This graph is showing the date by quarter (3 months). So the averages shown are by quarter.
- The first issue to note is that the 2015 average offering is still higher than the 2014 average. This is a positive sign. To be comfortable that we have enough funds for future ongoing operations, it would be better if the 2015 average were closer to the 2015 budget.
- The average for the third quarter of 2015 (July to September) has dropped significantly compared to earlier in the 2015 year. This is a concern .
- The "drop" has occurred in the electronic transfers, cheques, and cash methods of offering. This means that there is not a single cause of the issue.

There were approx 50% more people this year and that reflected into the finances also. The final outcome will not be known until expenses are calculated, but I think that final total for Casa Segura will be around \$3000—\$3300.
