Special Service this Sunday

This Sunday is going to be a special service where we take some time to recollect & reaffirm our Baptism, It is available for all those in the congregation who have previously been baptised. We have chosen to do this on 'Pentecost' which is the day on the Christian Calendar when we remember how the first disciples were baptised by the Holy Spirit.

Wouldn't it be something if everyone in the congregation wore some RED, which is the colour of the day, a colour which signifies the warmth of God's love and the power of God's Spirit to change our lives and lead us to live God's love and mercy.

The reaffirmation of baptism will follow the sharing of the message and will largely be in the form of a responsive litany. We will offer people the opportunity to come forward to the baptismal font to dip their fingers in the water & make the sign of the cross on their forehead or palm.

I want to stress that this should in no way be construed as a re-baptism, it is simply an opportunity to remind ourselves & reaffirm what took place in our original baptism. If you have never previously been baptised, and are interested please come and talk with me. Dan
