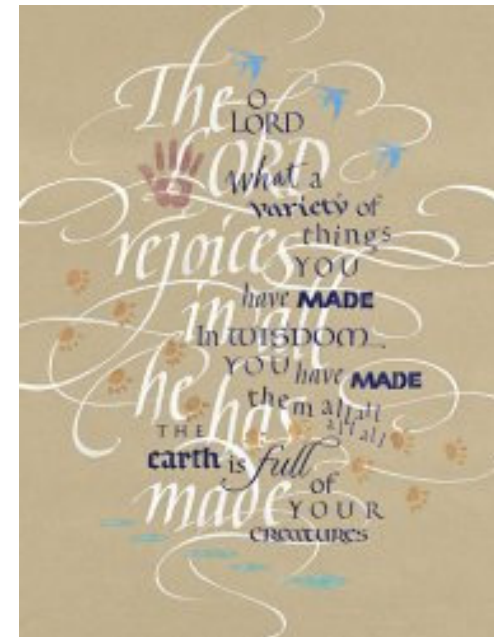

PAUL'S SERMON 21st OCTOBER

The "baptism" that will drown him is the baptism of his death as he suffocates to death on a cross.
