CHURCH BANKING DETAILS

With the closure of the QCCU office in Dayboro we needed to make suitable banking arrangements. The church now has a CBA savings account so that we can bank cash and cheques at a convenient CBA branch or a post office.

Anyone who transfers funds to the church (e.g. for offerings) can continue to use our QCCU account.

Anyone who wishes to bank cash/cheques to the church can either give this to Ian Ogston, Jenny Brown, Don Gemmell, and Maria Hansen or bank it directly to CBA account (BSB 064185; Account 10381294). If you bank money directly, please let Jenny know so she can identify its purpose when preparing the financial reports.

This is still our main operating account - **QCCU BSB 704-640 Account 22046043**

Currently we are waiting to see if a financial institution responds to Moreton Bay Regional Council's Expression of Interest for a banking facility to be set up in Dayboro. If that happens, Church Council would consider transferring all banking operation to this financial institution in order to support the local community.

Uniting Church National Assembly.

The triennial National Assembly of the Uniting Church met over the week of 7th to 14th July in Melbourne, from where the Chair of our Moreton Rivers Presbytery, Rev. Yvonne McRostie has advised that it resolved a number of significant items.

- affirming that the First Peoples of Australia, the Aboriginal and Islander Peoples, are sovereign peoples in this land;
- the installation of Dr Deidre Palmer as President and election of Rev Sharon Hollis as President-Elect; and
- adopting statements on family and domestic violence and disability access.
- adopting the statement 'For the whole of creation' regarding our ongoing responsibility to walk gently on this earth.

One topic that received a lot of attention throughout Assembly was same-gender marriage. This is an issue that the Uniting Church has been discussing for over 20 years and deliberation occurred across a number of sessions with input from passionate and faithful members that hold distinct and contradictory views.

The 15th Assembly of the Uniting Church in Australia has agreed to hold two equal and distinct views on marriage to honour the diversity of Christian belief among its members. More information is available on the website here: <https://uniting.church/freedom-to-decide-on-marriage/>.
