CHURCH BANKING DETAILS

With the closure of the QCCU office in Dayboro we needed to make suitable banking arrangements.

The church now has a CBA savings account so that we can bank cash and cheques at a convenient CBA branch or a post office.

Anyone who transfers funds to the church (e.g. for offerings) can continue to use our QCCU account.

Anyone who wishes to bank cash/cheques to the church can either give this to lan Ogston, Jenny Brown, Don Gemmell, and Maria Hansen or bank it directly to CBA account (BSB 064185; Account 10381294). If you bank money directly, please let Jenny know so she can identify its purpose when preparing the financial reports.

This is still our main operating account - QCCU BSB 704-640 Account 22046043

Currently we are waiting to see if a financial institution responds to Moreton Bay Regional Council's Expression of Interest for a banking facility to be set up in Dayboro. If that happens, Church Council would consider transferring all banking operation to this financial institution in order to support the local community.
