## NEWS from SYNOD

The 32<sup>nd</sup> Synod of the Uniting Church was an educational and inspirational experience, and a powerful reminder of who the UCA is in Queensland and why we journey together. Highlights were:

- Keynote speaker Dr Neil Preston on “Christian Witness in a Post-Christian Era”. He challenged the Church to centre on Christ and to “Be still and know that I am God”.
- Worship and Bible study by members from various cultural backgrounds - Korean, Samoan, Tonga, Sudanese, Aboriginal and Fijian.
- Reports from the various arms of the UCA shared their joys, fears, successes and challenges.
- Rev David Baker was elected as Moderator for a second term (October 2017 to October 2020) and Rev Heather den Houting was elected as General Secretary.
- “Synod Unchained” - the opportunity to interact with a variety of speakers on a number of “dangerous ideas” such as:
  - The Jihad of Jesus: Do we have a monopoly on Jesus?
  - Should we close our churches on Sundays
  - Is it time to rebrand the Uniting Church... for a different time?
  - How will offering sanctuary to asylum seekers change our world and our church?
  - Less property ... more mission?

The *Priority Directions for the Church from 2016 to 2020* was revised and passed as follows:

*The Synod, as part of its journey of “Together on the Way, enriching community”, adopts as its priority directions for 2016 – 2020:*

- *to be Christ centred, at prayer, and listening*
- *Discipleship*
- *Leadership*
- *Connecting with communities*
- *Youth, children and families*

*as the church grows, transitions and innovates.*

These directions align strongly with our vision at Dayboro UCA.
