CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING 24/07/2014



1. Work on fixing the leaking roof on the deck has been completed.
2. Richard is to manage the acquisition of a new table lectern in memory of Peter Oelrich.
3. \$500 is to be made available to continue the excellent work of the Friday Conversation Club.
4. Richard is to approach our local state member for support for our established and well-run Welfare Program.
5. Richard is managing the acquisition of the new audio system for the church in association with Ian Flinders. The appropriate equipment has been selected and should be installed shortly.
6. Selected material from the local Presbytery and the central office of the Uniting Church (e.g. training courses) is to be made available to the congregation via the weekly newsletter.
7. Heather is meeting with the kitchen suppliers to continue the process of refurbishing the kitchen. As well, Heather is researching the most appropriate appliances for the new kitchen (e.g. dishwasher – yes!!!!).
8. Chris is assembling a register of members of the congregation who have Blue Cards and those that have first aid qualifications. Please see Chris if you have either of these.
8. Carolyn is monitoring the First Aid boxes in the church and investigating the possibility of running a one-day first aid course for interested people.
9. Bill and Ann report that the Welfare committee is supporting seven families in the Dayboro area with food parcels and in other ways.
10. Leanne is to purchase a new set of a table and chairs of a more appropriate size for small children in Sunday Space.
11. Glyn has investigated the possibility of putting in a disabled toilet. At this stage, what we have is suitable but there will be a need to put in a mini ramp leading from the hall to the back landing and another leading into the ladies toilet. Glyn is following up on getting this done.
Glyn is also making the double door from the deck to the hall more secure.
12. Richard is organising new signs for the front of the church.
13. Jenny's finance report will be available shortly when she meets with Lesley on her return.
