## Remembrance Day Service - 10.45am 11th November

Paul is taking the service this year and it is an important year, being 99 years since the Armistice was signed, 100 years since the Light Horse Brigade Charge on Beersheba, 75 years since the Kokoda Campaign and 70 Years since the first group of Australian soldiers wore the blue beret as United Nations Peace Keepers. Carmel has been helping Paul re-

search all of this. It seems possible that Dayboro had a member of the 4th Light Horse Brigade in that famous 1917 ANZAC cavalry charge on Beersheba across the Negev Desert that favourably changed the course of the war. His name was Private Alfred Poulsen from Lacey's Creek. Of note too, is the son of Mary Wyatt. Luke was a member of the Interfet Peace Keepers in Timor in 2002.
