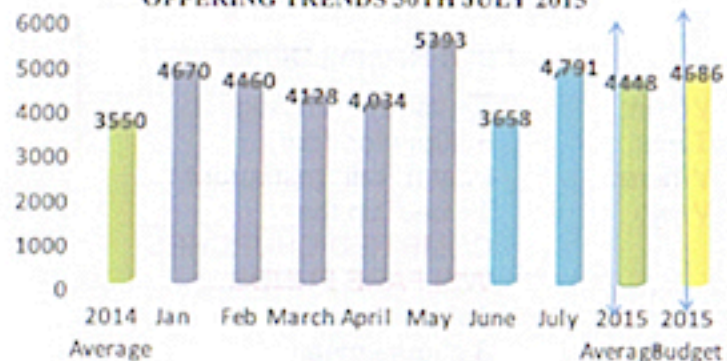

OFFERING TRENDS 30TH JULY 2015



1. The monthly offering had been dropping since January until May which has the highest monthly offering for 2015.
2. June having the lowest offering this year and July having an increase, partly explained by 28th June offering not being banked until July.
3. Monthly fluctuations even out if a graph showing collections by quarter is used. Second quarter 2015 is down \$173 compared to first quarter.
4. Offering data is less than budget required to operate church. We are relying on events like Dayboro Day to keep us financial for standard operations. We also are currently relying on donations to help with 'lumpy' expenditure such as Termite treatment and back porch repairs.
