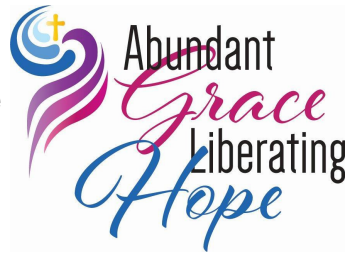
TAIZE SERVICE FRIDAY 8 MARCH 2019 AT DAYBORO UNITING CHURCH

All are invited to join in a time of fellowship and worship in the Taize tradition as we begin Lent on Friday 8 March. We start with a shared dinner at 6pm, service at 7pm, followed by dessert at 7.45pm. Please bring a small plate of food to share—gluten free will be provided.

TAIZE is an ecumenical meditative type of prayer service. The singing of repetitive simple chants and times of silence are used to enrich and deepen the prayer experience for the community and the individual. All are welcome to join us for this candle lit prayer service where we will take time in God's presence to begin the season of Lent in a spirit of love, kindness and reconciliation. The times of silence vary for 3 to approx 8 minutes.

LENTEN STUDIES—5 WEEKS PRIOR TO EASTER

Why: The season of Lent calls us to deepen our journey with Christ. Participating in a Lenten Studies series is also an opportunity to reflect and respond to the theme of the 15th UCA Assembly: *Abundant Grace Liberating Hope*. President Dr Deidre Palmer describes this theme as "an invitation to live by God's abundant grace – reflecting God's generous and overflowing love, in our relationships with one another, in our local community contexts and in our relationships in the wider world." What a great way for us to enter the Easter celebrations!



What: These Lenten studies will be offered over five Fridays in Lent and will be based in the series of *We wish to See Jesus*. The studies are based around the Gospel reading for the Sundays of Lent and are a gentle and sharing time of prayer, gospel reflection, hymn and graced silence (Christian meditation) - about 80-90minutes. The series is now out of print but we have permission to copy it for our studies.

Dates: Five Fridays before Easter: 15 March, 22 March, 29 March, 5 April, 12 April

Times: Two times have been suggested:

9:30-11:30am with shared morning tea and/or 6:00-8:00pm with shared finger food dinner
